Gregory (Greg) Lohnes is Chairman of TC PipeLines GP, Inc. (general partner of TC PipeLines, LP) and has been a Director since January 2007. He is also the former Chief Financial Officer of TC PipeLines GP, Inc.

Mr. Lohnes' principal occupation is President, Natural Gas Pipelines of TransCanada, a position he has held since July 1, 2010. Greg will have overall responsibility for TransCanada's gas pipeline and regulated gas storage businesses in Canada, the U.S. and Mexico. Prior to this, Mr. Lohnes was Executive Vice-President and Chief Financial Officer.

From August 2000 until June 2006, Mr. Lohnes was President and Chief Executive Officer of Great Lakes Gas Transmission Company. During his tenure, Great Lakes was a 50/50 joint venture between TransCanada and El Paso Corporation.

Mr. Lohnes joined TransCanada in 1993 and has held various executive positions in the areas of joint ventures pipelines, midstream and international. He also held management positions in Finance.

Prior to joining TransCanada, Mr. Lohnes worked as a corporate and securities lawyer for a major Alberta law firm. Mr. Lohnes is a member of the Law Society of Alberta.

Mr. Lohnes holds a Bachelor of Commerce from the University of Guelph and a Bachelor of Laws from the University of Calgary.

TC PipeLines, LP (NYSE: TCP) has interests in 5,560 miles of federally regulated U.S. interstate natural gas pipelines which serve markets across the United States and Eastern Canada.
