Stuart Kampel was appointed Vice-President and General Manager of TC PipeLines GP, Inc. (general partner of TC PipeLines, LP) in July 2011. Previously, Mr. Kampel was Vice-President, Business Development for the partnership. Mr. Kampel also holds the position of Director, Pipeline Development with TransCanada Corporation, a position he has held since December 2003.

Mr. Kampel has extensive knowledge of the North American natural gas market. In his history with TransCanada, he has been responsible for identifying and pursuing natural gas pipeline and other related energy investment opportunities in the United States and Mexico. From 2003 through 2011, Mr. Kampel was responsible for TransCanada's business development initiatives in Mexico. This effort led to the successful developments of the Tamazunchale gas pipeline in east-central Mexico and the Manzanillo – Guadalajara gas pipeline in western Mexico.

Mr. Kampel joined TransCanada's pipeline business development group in 1995 where he was responsible for identifying and pursuing greenfield pipeline projects and other pipeline investment opportunities in the Midwestern and western United States. Prior to that, Mr. Kampel worked within the market and competitive analysis group where he assessed TransCanada's competitive position in North America. He joined TransCanada in 1991 working as an analyst in the rates and tariffs department.

Mr. Kampel earned a Bachelor of Commerce degree from the University of Calgary, Alberta and a Master of Business Administration from Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
